1. **Copyright:** By submitting your work to our exhibition, we assume that you are confirming that you are the sole owner of the copyright of the images you are submitting. You confirm that the work you submit do not violate any copyright, trademark, privacy, or other proprietary rights of any third party. You indemnify us against any third-party claims or disputes related to the work submitted.
2. **Display:** Your work will be displayed during the exhibition for public viewing. The work will not be sold, distributed, or used for any commercial purposes other than the promotion of the festival without mutual agreement.
3. **License:** Unless specifically agreed otherwise in writing with the copyright owner, Photo | Frome assumes that the organisers of our physical exhibitions, symposiums, talks, workshops, websites, social media, printed documentation, and other related activities have been granted a non-exclusive licence to use submitted items as they judge appropriate in the execution of Photo | Frome's programmes. This includes a non-exclusive licence to promote those activities publicly on, e.g., social media, websites, printed programme materials, and other promotional collateral.
4. **Work:** this includes but is not limited to photographs (physical and digital uploads), installations, profiles, project descriptions, biographies, books, zines, digital files.
5. **Ownership:** You retain copyright of your work, and we will not claim ownership or copyright of your work.
6. **Liability:** While we take every precaution to ensure the safety and security of the prints, we cannot be held responsible for any loss, damage, theft, or destruction of the prints. We will insure your work at agreed replacement value for the duration of the festival.
7. **Usage:** You grant us permission to use images you provide in promotional materials related to the exhibition and the festival, including online and print media. We will always credit you as the photographer although we cannot guarantee third party media outlets will use this credit.
8. **Withdrawal:** If you wish to withdraw your work from the exhibition, please notify us in writing with 7 days' notice to our email address [info@photofrome.org](mailto:info@photofrome.org)
9. **Disclaimer:** In all cases, you agree that the work exhibited represents your views and not necessarily those of Photo | Frome or its founders.
10. **Indemnity:** Whilst we endeavour to ensure that all exhibitions, talks, workshops, and portfolio reviews will take place as advertised, sometimes things are out of our control. We will endeavour to pre-announce about any such changes. However, Photo | Frome can take no liability for such changes or cancellations impacting, e.g., personal travel costs.
